



- Cold War (1945 to 1989)
 - Conflict between US and USSR (Russia)
 - Communism VS Democracy
- 1980's
- 1979 USSR Invades Afghanistan
 - The US which did not want to get in a direct conflict with the Soviet Union (USSR), would aid Afghan rebels to prevent the Soviet Union from being successful.

 - By giving them intel, weapon, and training
 - Leader of the Rebels was Osama Bin Laden

 Bin Laden and The War in Afghanistan






- Bin Laden is the son of a Billionaire from Saudi Arabia
 - Henchmen of Bin Laden
 - Sheikh Mohammed
 - Master Mind of 9/11
 - · Went to school in the US
 - Bin Laden is seen as an Afghan Hero
 - Leading Jihad (holy war) against a world super power (USSR) and winning.
 - 1986 War going well, thanks to US support of Rebels (stinger missiles)
 - Bin Laden builds organization (al-Qaeda) throughout world
 - Able to because of his success
 - 32 Stations in the US (recruiting centers)
 - 1988 USSR pulls out of Afghanistar


Iraq War (Gulf War) 1990

- Saddam Hussein invades Kuwait
 - · Leader of Iraq
 - For oil
- Bin Laden asks Saudi Arabia to let him defend the homeland
 - With his Holy Fighters
- Saudi Arabia says NO and asks the US for help
- Bin Laden is humiliated and becomes very angry that his home land is going to invite infidels into their country

 Al-Qaeda and Bin Laden in the 90's



- 1991 Bin Laden is exiled (kick out) from Saudi Arabia
 - Goes to Sudan
- February 1993 1st attack on World Trade Center
 - Truck bomb, with 6 dead and 1000 wounded
- Al-Qaeda responsible for Black Hawk Down
 - US military was in Somalia helping to hand out food to the starving.
 - In a mission gone wrong US Black Hawks are shot down and US solders are killed and captured.
 - US pulls out of Somalia.

 - 1996 Bin Laden kicked out of Sudan & goes back to Afghanistan

 Al-Qaeda and Bin Laden in the 90's

- Bin Laden calls for a Jihad against the US and wants them to leave Saudi Arabia
- - Taliban is a strict Islamic State, that believes in Sharia Law
- - Theft is punishable by amputation of the hands (**Quran 5:38** includes graphic image).

 Criticizing or denying any part of the **Quran** is punishable by

 Criticizing Muhammad or denying that he is a prophet is punishable by death.

Criticizing or denying Allah is punishable by death (see Allah)

• A Muslim who becomes a non-Muslim is punishable by death (See **Compulsion**).

• A non-Muslim who leads a Muslim away from Islam is punishable by death.

A non-Muslim man who marries a Muslim woman is punishable by

A woman or girl who has been raped cannot testify in court

against her rapist(s).

• Testimonies of 4 male witnesses are required to prove rape of a female (Quran 24:13).

- > A woman or girl who alleges rape without producing 4 male witnesses is guilty of adultery.
- A woman or girl found guilty of adultery is punishable by death (see "Islamophobia").
 A male convicted of rape can have his conviction dismissed by marrying his victim.
- A woman can have 1 husband, who can have up to 4 wives; Muhammad can have more.
- A man can beat his wife for insubordination (see Quran 4:34 and Religion of Peace).
 A man can unilaterally divorce his wife; a wife needs her husband's consent to divorce.
- A female heir inherits half of what a male heir inherits (see Mathematics in Quran).
 A woman cannot drive a car, as it leads to fitnah (upheaval).
 A woman cannot speak alone to a man who is not her husband or relative.
 Meat to eat must come from animals that have been sacrificed to Allah i.e., be "Halal."

What Bin Laden Wants

- 1996 The plan for 9/11 is in place
 - The goal of 9/11 was to encourage the US to attack Bin Laden on his home turf of Afghanistan.
 - 1998 The US tried to kill Bin Laden, but failed.
- Bin Laden says fight will go on till US troops are out of Saudi Arabia.
 - 1998 US Embassies are bombed in Kenya and Tanzania.
 - 2000 Al-Qaeda bombs the USS Cole and kills 17 sailors
 - Bin Laden believes if the US attacks him it will unite the Muslim world against the Western world.
 - September 11th 2001 4 planes are hijacked, 2 planes hit the two towers at the World Trade Center. 1 plane hits the Pentagon, and 1 crashes in Pennsylvania.







AFTER 9/11 THE MEMORIALS

• 9/11 Memorial and Museum

- Called Reflecting Absence Commemorating the 2001 & 1993 attacks
- Made up of 2 square reflecting pools in the center marking where the twin towers stood.
- The waterfalls that fall into the reflecting pools are the largest man-made waterfall in the US
- The waterfalls symbolize the loss of life and the physical void left by the attacks.
- The names of 2983 victims are inscribed around the pools.
- The pools are surrounded by a forest of 400 swamp white oak trees.
- Construction began in 2006 and finished in 2011.
- Total cost of the memorial and museum is over \$700 million.
- The Memorial and Museum have an operational cost of \$63 million a year.








AFTER 9/11 THE MEMORIALS

Pentagon Memorial:

- At the point of impact the American's Heroes Memorial and Chapel was created and opened on September 2002.
- The outside memorial was 1.93 acers with 184 benches raising from the ground hovering over a pool of lighted water.
- Each bench has a name of 1 of the 184 victims.
- Benches are arranged by age starting with the youngest victim (age 3) to the oldest (age 71).
- 85 paperback maple trees were planted.
- Cost was \$32 million for construction and upkeep.
- Called the everlasting tribute to the 184 souls who perished.
- Dedicated in 2008







AFTER 9/11 THE MEMORIALS

- Flight 93 National Memorial
 - Two parts
 - Tower of Voices
 - Dedicated in 2018
 - The tower serves as both a visual and audible reminder of the heroism of the 40 passengers and crew of United Flight 93.
 - 93 feet tall the tower has 40 wind chimes one for each of the 40 passengers and crew.
 - Each Chime plays a distinct musical note (voice) for each person.
 - Cost \$6 million
 - National Memorial
 - Located 2 miles north of Shanksville, Pennsylvania
 - 2002 Congress passed the "Flight 93 National Memorial Act"
 - 2200 acres and competed in 2015
 - A wall of names circles the impact site.
 - Cost \$60 million.

US Response & World

- 9/12 --- Bush says "There will be no distinction between the terrorists that commit the act and the countries that harbor them".
- All planes grounded for 4 days
- Stock market closed for 6 days
- 2002 US started holding terrorists at Guantanamo Bay, Cuba.
- May 2011 Navy Seals shot and killed Bin Laden.
- This attack leads us to two wars:
 - Afghanistan: October 7th 2001
 - Iraq War: Invaded Iraq with the fear that Saddam Hussein will give terrorists weapons of mass destruction.
 - NATO Declared that 9/11 was an attack on the entire alliance.

GETTING BACK TO NORMAL

- Planes grounded
 - It took 4 days till planes were able to go back up in the sky
- Stock Market Closed
 - Took 6 days for the markets to open
 - Longest shut down since the Great Depression
- News Coverage
 - After 24 hour non stop coverage, TV when back to normal coverage after 2 weeks.

GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

- The President
 - Bush Says "There will be no distinction between the terrorists that commit the act and the countries that harbor them".
- War in Afghanistan
 - October 2001 Mission to take down the Taliban and to destroy al-Qaeda
 - Longest military campaign in US history
 - Take the fight to Bin Laden
- War in Iraq
 - Invaded Iraq with the fear that Saddam Hussein will give terrorists weapons of mass destruction.
- Between Afghanistan & Iraq over 6000 US solders have died and 43,399 wounded since 2011.
- 140,000 Afghans lives lost
- NATO declared that 9/11 was an attack on the entire alliance

GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

- Department of Homeland Security
 - Protect the territory of the US
 - 3rd largest cabinet department
 - Coordinate with other agencies
- Patriot Act
 - Passed by Congress
 - Gave government more powers of surveillance, investigation, and detention of suspects.
 - Easier to search homes, cars, monitor phone calls, emails, and records.
 - Could detain indefinitely (non citizens)

GOVERNMENT RESPONSE

- Airport Security
 - Created the TSA in 2001 (Transportation Security Administration) with a budget of \$7.8 billion
 - Before 9/11 only %5 of bags checked, now they all are
 - · Shoes removed
 - Air Marshals
 - Liquid ban
 - Pat downs
 - Cockpit doors locked

LASTING AFFECTS

- Muslim American Discrimination
 - Assaults in 2000 (12) Assaults after 9/11 (93)
 - Mosques shooting in New Zealand killed 51
- Price of Oil
 - Before 9/11 \$22 per barrel
 - After 9/11 \$95.73 per barrel
- 9/11 Illnesses
 - 2,448 1st responders have died from 9/11 illnesses
 - Respiratory, digestive diseases, cancers and more

Other Attacks

New Attacks:

- Anthrax sent in letters to the Capital (Kills 5 people).
- 2002 Bombs in Indonesia (202 Killed).
- 2004 Backpack bombs in Madrid, Spain (191 Killed).
- 2005 Bombs in London Subways (52 Killed).
- 2005 Car bombs in Egypt (31 Killed)
- 2013 Boston Marathon Bombing (3 Killed)
- 2015 Charlie Hebdo shooting (12 Killed)
- 2016 Orlando nightclub shooting (49 killed)
- · And More.

Affects of 9/11 on the US

- Weakened our Economy
- Less dependent on foreign fuel.
- Big national debt of over \$16.7 trillion.
- 2002 Sheikh Mohammed Captured
- Anti-Islamic violence goes up.
 - 28 to 481
- Clean-up of 9/11:
 - New York done in May 2002
 - Pentagon rebuilt by June 2002
 - Pennsylvania Memorial built

Affects of 9/11 on the US

- 2740 people died in the Towers.
- 189 people died in the Pentagon.
- 44 people died on United 93.
- 2973 Total people died on September 11th, 2001.
- Afghanistan War: 2325 Killed and 20,083 Wounded
- Iraqi Freedom: 4,424 Killed and 31,952 Wounded

Terrorist Groups in the Middle East that you should know:

- Al-Qaeda --- (Sunni) Wants to get rid of all foreign influences in Muslim countries. Wants 1 leader for all Muslims
- Islamic State of Iraq (ISIL) (Sunni) They claim religious,
 political, military authority over all
 Muslims. They control areas in Iraq and
 Syria and they enforce Sharia Law.
- Sharia (Islamic Law) Derived from the Quran Enforces
 law on crime, politics, economics,
 sexual behavior, hygiene, diet, prayer,
 and more.
- Hamas (Sunni) Palestinian Territories, Gaza Strip Want to liberate Palestinians. They use suicide bombers and rockets.
- Hezbollah (Shi'a) In Lebanon and gets help from Iran.
- Iran (Shi'a) Independent nation in the Middle East.
