1. Learn about the political and physical geography of the Southwest Asia (Middle East).
  - a. Map assignment – Two maps: 1<sup>st</sup> map, labeling countries and capitals 2<sup>nd</sup> map labeling physical features.
  - b. Students will be tested on countries and capitals (know location and say in 30 seconds) and physical geography (know location).
