

Dear Parents, Teachers, and PEAKers,

I hope you've been hearing a lot about your child's Independent Study project. We're well on our way! Students have been conducting internet research in class. And last week, students gathered materials from the Lewis & Clark Library, including checking out books and getting photocopies of reference materials with the help of librarians Molly and Emmon (if you see them, please tell them "thanks!") Lastly, we've started writing questions for expert interviews and making some preliminary contacts to get in touch with many experts.

This week we'll begin another phase of this project. Professional artist Katie Knight will be helping us to create incredible art projects using a process called cyanotype. This process uses a special coating on paper to create a developed image (much like developing a photograph). We'll be combining this technique with another interesting process involving watercolors and salt. We are very excited to see how these will turn out, and they will also be a part of the students' Independent Study presentations.

We also hope to complete the students' interview questions and have at least one expert for each student to contact on their own. Interviews should hopefully all be done by the time we return from Spring Break.

Please watch your email for details about our upcoming trip to MSU on April 23! We'll be working with various professors and MSU students, and our students will get to present their Independent Study presentations to MSU education students for critique and feedback.
