Dear Parents, Teachers, and PEAKers,

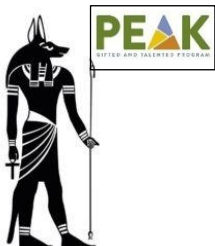

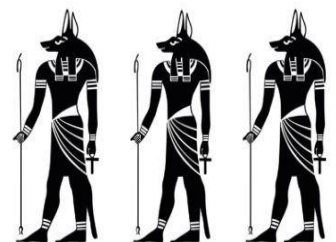
This Week's Activities: Sept. 8 - 12

<p>Research: Internet I can navigate the internet and collect relevant research, including citations, with teacher guidance.</p>	<p>Egyptian Myth 101 - Students will get an overview of ancient Egyptian mythology and will learn about the major characters with a partner in a learn-and-share activity.</p>
<p>Intrapersonal: Self-Expression I can express my own interests, values, emotions, etc. within a project with teacher guidance.</p>	<p>Who am I? - Students will complete an activity to identify and share attributes about themselves. What are they good at? What are they afraid of? What supernatural power would they like to have? These attributes will be used in a later activity.</p>
<p>Interpersonal: Collaboration I can cooperate and effectively contribute to a team with teacher guidance.</p>	<p>The Specifics of the Space - Students will acquaint themselves with our two PEAK classrooms, the cafeteria, the playground, and other Rossiter spaces, while meeting and interacting with Rossiter staff members. They will also collaboratively create a PEAK Classroom Code of Conduct for the year, complete with hieroglyphic symbols for each.</p>
