GOAL:

Students will become proficient at self-advocacy, self-assessment, and the learner outcomes for all curricular areas. Subject specific goals:

- Science Students will use critical thinking and science and engineering practices to develop a better understanding of the way things work in the world surrounding us. Science can be thought of as having three major components:
 - Science is a body of knowledge.
 - Science is a *process*, and a way of investigating.
 - Science is a way of knowing or constructing understanding about the natural world.

Through the year, students will...

- demonstrate and practice lab safety
- utilize the metric system
- apply science and engineering practices as they identify, investigate and discuss the characteristics of physical science

ASSESSMENT PROCESS AND GRADING:

Students achievement of the standards will be assessed by formative and summative methods throughout the year. Grades will be updated weekly, and late work/absent work will be graded each WEDNESDAY. HMS sends grades home at mid-quarter and quarter, as well as needed or requested. Parents and students can access grades at any time through PowerSchool. Course grades will be weighted in two categories: habits of work (formative assessments including check your understanding work, etc.) 30%, standards achievement (summative/final products like end of chapter quizzes, models, end of unit tests, science seminar, etc.) 70%.

MISCELLANEOUS ITEMS:

- ✓ The Weekly Agenda is updated each Monday morning prior to school. This agenda will detail activities and homework for the week. You will find a link to this agenda on my webpage, as well as in the weekly agenda you will receive via email. It is also posted on our TEAMS page.
- ✓ I am available and would be more than happy to assist you with any work you are finding difficult. Feel free to e-mail me or send me a chat on TEAMS. If you need in person help, please plan with me during class.
- ✓ Late work/Absent work/Corrections will be graded each Wednesday.

- ✓ Any missing work must be completed by the last day of that unit (unit test day). Any extensions needed must be requested/approved prior to the last day of the unit (unit test day).
- ✓ If you are absent, please check the Weekly Agenda and your Assignments on TEAMS to complete the missed work. Your time for completion after an absence follows that in the school handbook (2 days for each day absent, maximum of 4 days); however, I am more than willing to work with you to come up with a different plan should you need it.
