Last week at PEAK, Mon-Wed students travelled to the Lewis and Clark Library and found materials for their Independent Study project. Most students were able to find both reference material and books to check out. Later in the day, students had time to look more closely at their books. In the afternoon, we will do some brainstorming related to our upcoming interview. Students will begin looking for experts in the field that they have chosen for their Independent Study topic. If we have time, we'll even start developing some interview questions for these upcoming interviews! A very busy week for everyone!

<u>Research: Online and Print</u> – I can gather relevant information from various source types with teacher guidance, including citations. <u>Communication: Outlines</u> – I can create a framework for my research and upcoming presentation by making an outline that focuses on my interests. <u>Research:</u> Questioning Strategies: – I can generate "non-Googlable" interview questions with teacher help. I can include career and experience questions for my expert.
