## Attendance

## Daily Agendas

- Please check this frequently, especially if you are absent.


## Grading

- Practice will make up $40 \%$ of a student's final grade while assessment of mastery will account for $60 \%$ of the final grade. In math, however, assessments make up $80 \%$ of the final grade.
- On assessments, students will always have the opportunity to redo, rewrite, or retest to improve their understanding of a standard.
- Students have one week from when the assessment grade is posted in PowerSchool to redo.
- Students will need to complete additional practice and/or teacher conferencing BEFORE they can redo an assessment.
- Redo's will be done during advisor time or sometimes before/after school.
- Students may demonstrate mastery for an improved score.


## What do grades mean?

A $=90-100 \%$
Exceeds Proficient
$B=80-89 \% \quad$ Proficient
C $=70-79 \% \quad$ Nearing Proficiency
D $=60-69 \% \quad$ Not Proficient
F = below 60\% Not enough evidence to determine proficiency

## Due dates and late work

- Late work will be accepted for partial credit if it is turned in within one week of the assigned due date. - Late work will be graded after work that has been turned in on time.
