ROAD MAP – Your guide to completing the Latin America SWAY Project

GO: Tuesday, May 8 -- Begin your journey:

- 1. Team reads the prompt.
- 2. Team begins research on their selected country's push/pull factors,
- 3. Team makes a list of push factors and pull factors, then determine if those factors are environmental, economic, social or political.
- 4. Team writes a thesis statement that includes the three factors your team chooses to research.

STOP: END OF CLASS Tuesday, May 8:

Team MUST get the thesis sentence approved by teacher before moving the next leg of the journey.

GO: Wednesday-Thursday, May 9-10

- 1. Each team member chooses one of the three factors selected by the team and begins in depth research.
- 2. Each team member creates 2-column notes which include details and elaborations.
- 3. Each team member will keep track of the sources and include in-text citations on your 2-column notes.

STOP: Friday, May 11 - SEMESTER TEST

At this point in the journey, each student will use their two column notes to complete their semester test (see rubric) during a single class period.

GO: Monday, May 14 - HOMEWORK

Team members divide and conquer the hook and general info of the introduction, and the conclusion and bring drafts to school for TUESDAY

GO: Tuesday, May 15

- 1. Check in with your team to see if you need to complete tasks at home!!
- 2. Team members fix any edits in their individual body paragraphs.
- 3. Teams finalize introduction and conclusion.
- 4. Team members begin to collect AWESOME visuals that will enhance your presentation!!

GO: Wednesday - Friday, May 16-18

- 1. Check in with your team to see if you need to complete tasks at home!!
- 2. Build Sway slides (follow the checklist!!!!!)
- 3. Remember start by FIRST putting in all of your text!!
- 4. THEN start getting creative with graphics, background, theme and font.
