Sapphire Team Fieldtrips

The Sapphire Team knows that student success in middle school is rooted in building quality relationships with their teachers and fellow students.

During the year, our team will embark upon any number of school fieldtrips.

In years past, these opportunities have included excursions to theatres, live performances, outdoor activities, and even a day at the Museum of the Rockies in Bozeman!

Rather than charging for each individual field trip, we are asking each student to pay a one-time \$30 fee.

We also invite families that are able to help sponsor students on the team whose situations make it difficult to cover this cost.

On many of our field trips, students will need to have a sack lunch. Students may either bring one from home or order one from the school cafeteria (\$3).

Most of our field trips are only possible with some parental assistance. These are incredible experiences – your teachers strongly encourage all to participate (*including parents*)!
