Grading:

Your grade will be based on daily work, assignments, quizzes, tests, and projects which assess essential standards. The class TEAMS page is where most class information will be stored. **If class time is used wisely, minimal outside work will be required for English class.** I suggest an assignment notebook or calendar organization system to keep deadlines organized across all classes.

PowerSchool is the final authority for grades and missing work. TEAMS is a way to assign work and provide feedback to students and should not be used to determine missing work or grades.

The following grading scale will be used: 100-90=A, 89-80=B, 79-70=C, 69-60=D, 59 or less=F

Assignments/Instruction:

If you miss school, **it is your responsibility** to check with me to find out what you missed during that class period. Please send a chat on TEAMS to find a time we can work together. If your absence is a planned absence, it is best practice to arrange to collect work before you leave.

Any form of plagiarism or cheating will result in a zero grade and a referral. Plagiarized assignments are not eligible for a redo.

It is an expectation that work will be handed in on time. This helps build a life skill of learning to meet deadlines, and it also helps manage grading and providing feedback more efficiently. **Partial** credit will be given if the assignment is handed in late up to 7 days late (including weekend days). Assignments close seven days after the due date. I understand special circumstances happen, so please communicate with me so that we can create a plan for assignments past 7 days.

Please do not hesitate to contact me with any questions, concerns, or comments. E-mail is best for parent contact and TEAMS chat/call is best for student contact. Learning is a cooperative effort between the student, teacher, and parents/guardians; open communication is important.
