The following grading scale will be used: 100-90=A, 89-80=B, 79-70=C, 69-60=D, 59 or less=F

#### **Assignments/Instruction:**

If you miss school, it is your responsibility to check with me to find out what you missed during that class period. If your absence is a planned absence, it is best practice to arrange to collect work before you leave.
