Form the <u>pluperfect tense</u> by adding the imperfect of the verb "to be" to the perfect stem. ex. $voc\bar{o}$, $voc\bar{a}re$, $voc\bar{a}v\bar{\imath}$, (the perfect stem = $\underline{voc\bar{a}v}$ -) – add eram, erās, erat, erāmus, erātis, erant When you translate the "pluperfect" you must use the word "had".
