

## Dear Parents, Teachers, and PEAKers,

Students took their first steps back in time as they contributed to a HUGE classroom timeline, with over 200 entries! Each student chose at least three Turning Points in history to study in a "speed research" project. Every student gave a 1-minute presentation on each timeline item they contributed. Then, they placed a Post-It on our gigantic around-the-room historical timeline for each of their events so we can see when all of these important moments took place. We learned about so many amazing happenings throughout time!

This week, we'll use this new knowledge as a starting point as students each select their own individual topics of interest for their Independent Study research projects. After selecting a topic, each student will begin an Idea Web, a visual representation of how various areas of knowledge are related. The webs help them to organize thoughts, generate new ideas, act as a checklist of facts to find, and more.

They will also be working together with partners to find some personal Turning Points in common, and students will dramatize these in a roleplaying activity for the class.

## This Week's Activities: Jan. 23 - 26

Research: Independent Study I can choose a suitable topic for an in-depth research project.	<u>Turning Point Topics</u> - Students will each choose one final topic to research throughout this unit.		
Creativity: Elaboration (Webbing) I can expand my own ideas with minimal teacher guidance in a creative project.	<b>Weaving an Idea Web</b> - Students will create idea webs to widen their studies of their new Independent Study topics.		
Presentation Skills: Role Playing I can create a dramatic character from an original script and perform it authentically.	<u>Turning Points in Common</u> - Student partner pairs will choose a turning point they both have in common in their own lives. Then they will create and perform a skit to share it with the class.		
Creativity: Aesthetic Quality I can create projects that contain my own design choices such as color, style, pattern, etc. and describe why I chose them.	<u>Historical Avatars</u> - Students will create topic-related "avatars" that will be used to track their progress throughout this large-scale research project.
